THREE ALARMS SOUNDED

Storehouse of International Waste Co at South Boston Destroyed With Loss of \$35,000

Damage estimated at between \$35,000 and \$40,000 was caused yesterday morning by a three-alarm fire in a two-story building at 97 and 99 K st, South Boston, owned by Jesse Tirrell and occupied as a storehouse by the International Waste Company. It was filled largely with cotton and woolen waste.

The building was completely burned out. It is 25 years old and was formerly occupied by the Perkins Machine Company.
