

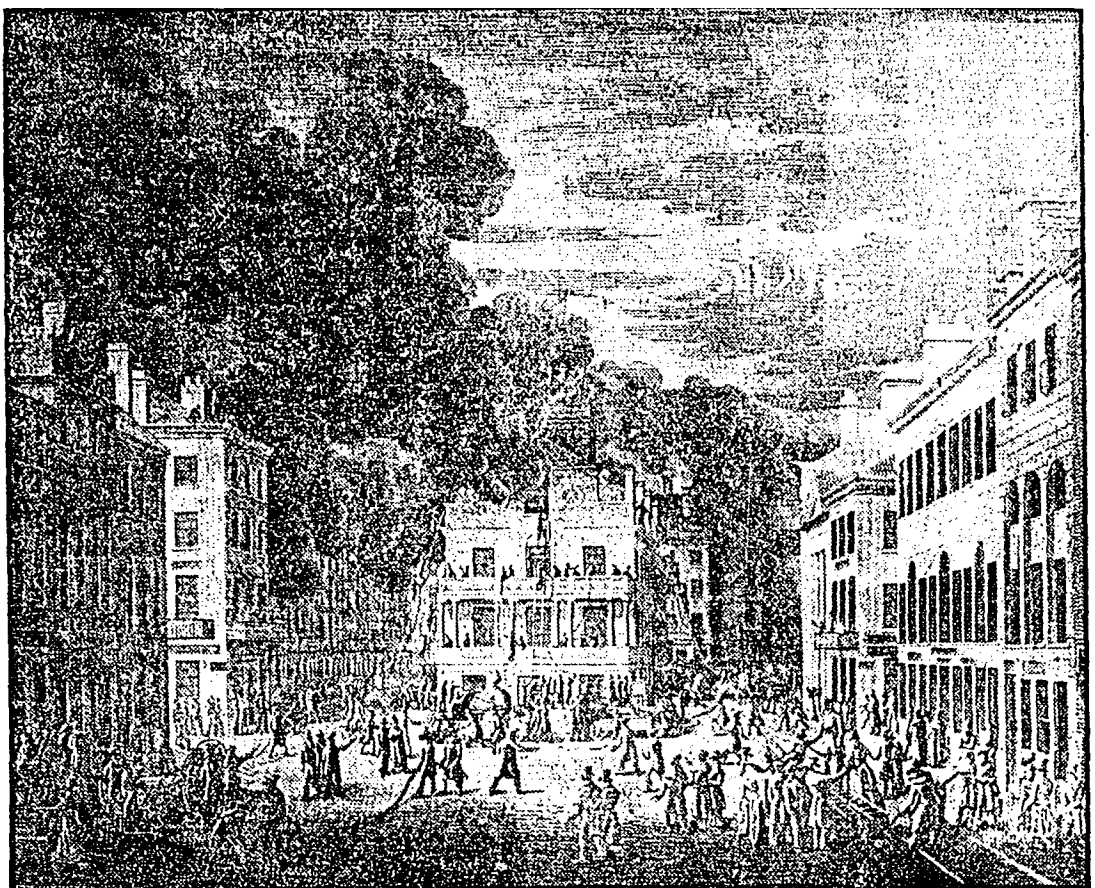

Fac-simile of the veteran's certificate recently issued to Chief William T. Cheswell in recognition of his 42 years' service with the Boston fire department. Only five such documents had previously been issued in the 60 years that the custom has been in vogue. Seven years of duty makes a Boston fireman eligible to receive such a document under the regulation providing the honor, but notwithstanding this, the distinction has been awarded only on rare occasions.
